Standing Rules for WSC Lake Trips

Expectations for Trip Patrons (this includes everyone on or involved with the event):

1. Remain sober while participating in all water sport activities. If a water craft owner/operator sees that you've become impaired, they have the right to deny you boat access. Out of line patrons can and will be denied access to the watercraft and Lake.
2. AT ALL TIMES! Be courteous, patient, unselfish, and kind to others! We are all on vacation. Don't be the bad attitude that ruins it.
3. Be proactive and communicate! The water craft owner/operators are not mind readers so talk with them.
4. Be courteous of the time you spend on Water and the boat please allow others to enjoy the boat/lake.
5. Please be courteous and mindful of the lake trip schedule. Be aware that the schedule can change and needs to be flexible.
6. If children are present, then please modify your behavior and be respectful of camp ground quiet hours.
7. If any lake participant is sited a ticket, it is their responsibility to pay the citation.

Expectations for WSC Boat Captains:

1. Water Craft Owners need to abide by State lake and Watercraft laws. If any lake participant is cited a ticket, it is their responsibility to pay the citation.
2. Try to minimize your time spent away from shore so that everyone can get a chance to ski/boat/ cruise. Each time a boat is ready to head out, please make it known if you have available spots.
3. If a watercraft owner/operator notices a trip patron behavioral problem and if it is possible, then contact the event coordinator to determine an appropriate plan of action. The owner ultimately is the final authority regarding all safety issues associated with their craft. Out of line patrons can and will be denied access to the watercraft.
4. If a break down occurs, the watercraft owner/ operator is responsible for the repairs. If repair is due to a participant's negligence, it is to be worked out between patron and boat owner.
5. If available, bring a diverse assortment of water sporting goods (Water-skis, Wake boards, Knee board, Tubes, etc.)
6. Reimbursement for watercraft owners will be for mileage and watercraft fuel used.
 - a. Mileage from home to lake per MapQuest @ IRS published rate plus 50%.
 - b. For watercraft fuel used on the lake. At end of the trip provide all receipts (fill up before trip, gas used on lake and fill up after trip) for all gas fill ups and Ski club will pay for fuel used on lake.
 - c. Boat usage is at discretion of Board as to how boats are used and if they will be used again.

Expectations for the Trip Captain:

1. It is your responsibility to contact the watercraft owners prior to the trip to find out their availability during the weekend. Review the watercraft owner's expectations list and assure compliance. If owners have any concerns, it should be brought up at this time.
2. The trip captain, shall provide a trip flyer with pertinent information to each patron, including, but not limited to, genitive schedule, boat owners and availability of boats.
